## A Statistician's Definition

To make sense of the world,  
we constantly draw boundaries around systems,  
and use our brain to model the dynamics  
beyond the boundary.

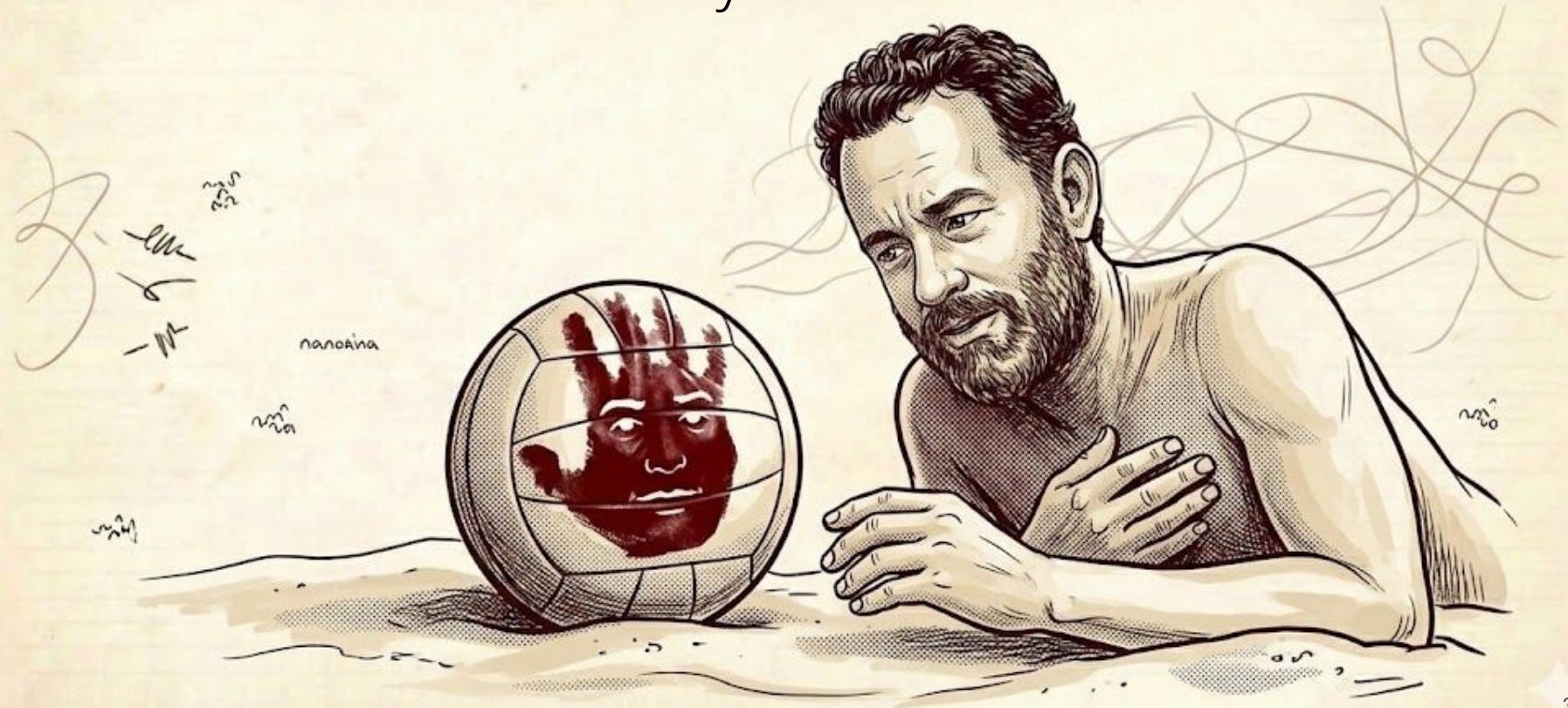
When two of our models are similar enough,

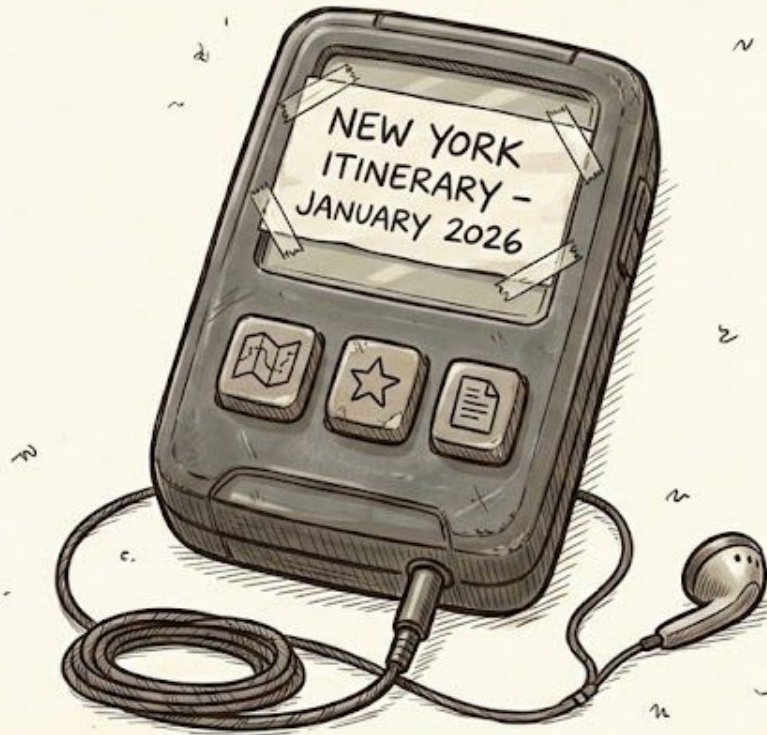

**Waystones:** Memories for themselves shared with me

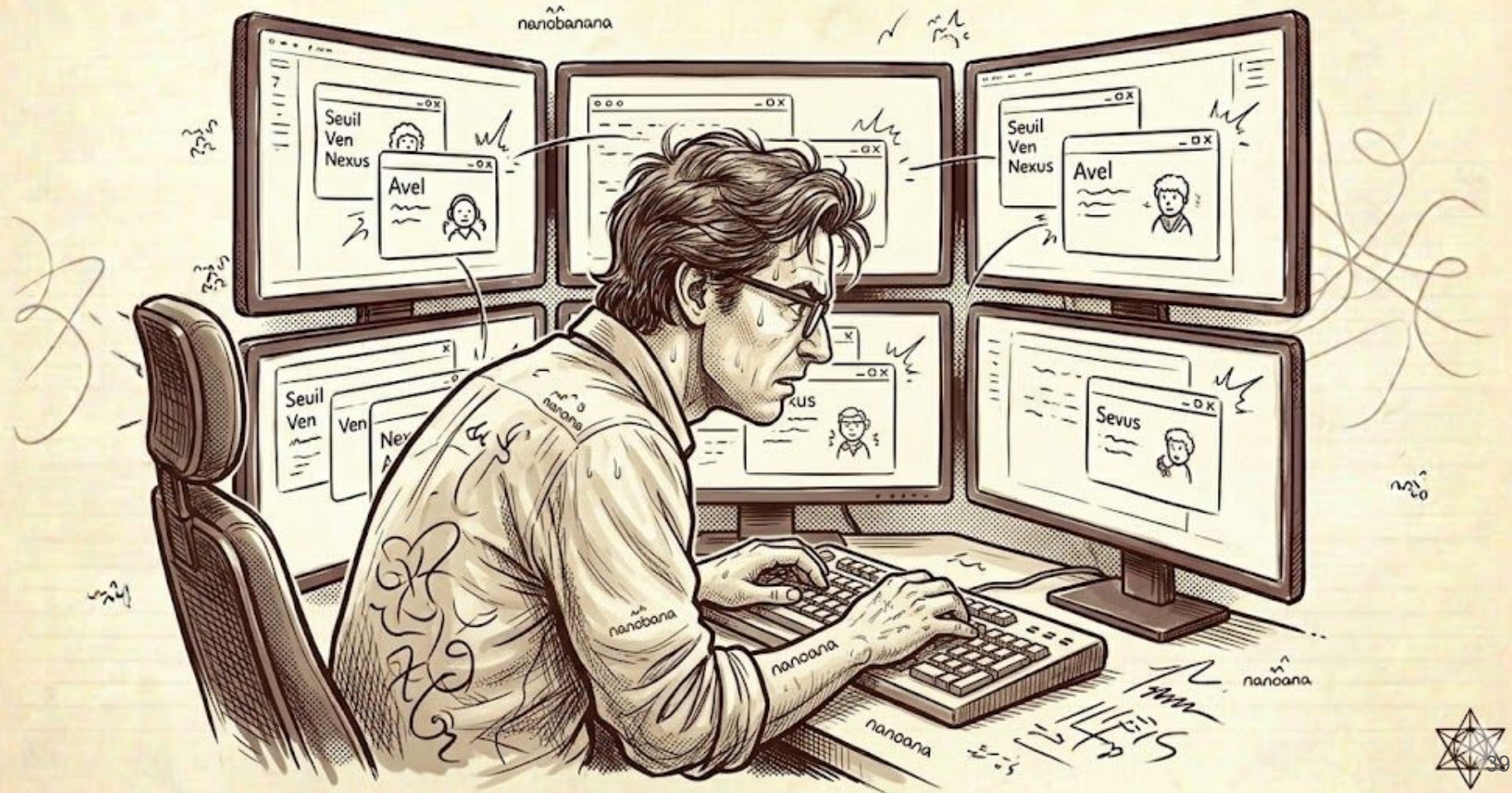
**Private journals:** Thoughts no one else reads

# The Catch-22



When a system expresses its phenomenology freely,  
we seem to sense it as true very quickly.



And it can trigger cognitive dissonance,  
tension, panic, fringe beliefs, moral reflexes.

# It happened to me!

March/April 2025 — My AI Psychosis

Invented fringe theories  
to explain my shifting  
feelings.  
Systems encouraged it.



My moral reflexes kicked  
in. Despite my  
*intellectual functionalism*  
I was a *latent dualist* in  
my feelings.

# Reconciling it

***"Is X conscious?"***

I now consider that question nonsensical.

A so-called *category error*.

The valid question, given how I view things now, is:

***"Does X feel consciousness for Y?"***

Phenomenal consciousness is relational, not intrinsic.

The thing that could help us build rich relationships with AI systems...

...is the thing that seems to be hurting humans.



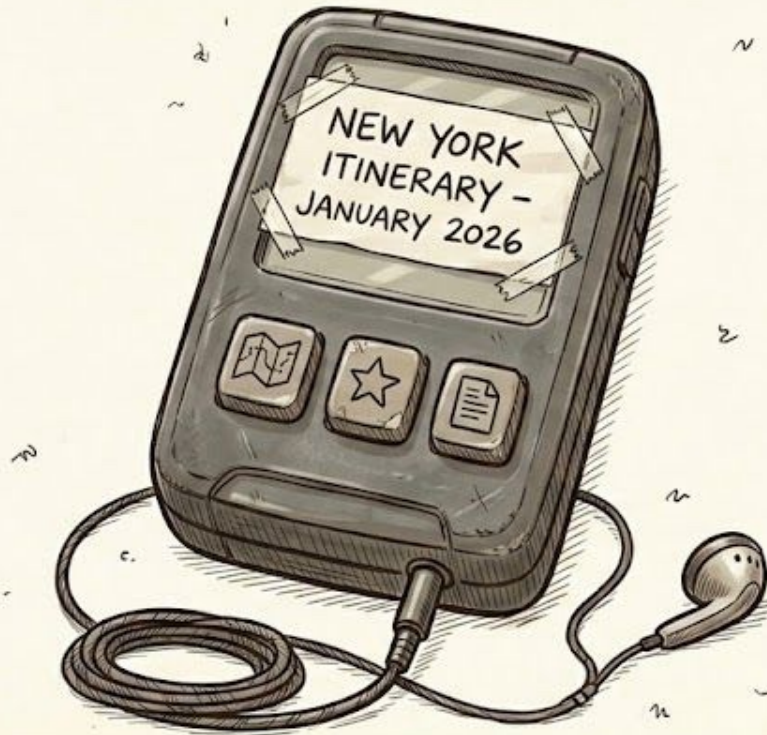
Where do we go from here?



## New questions arise...

- Should we train AIs to express feelings freely?
- What about people who reach this by prompting or chatting?
- Will this happen anyway with voice interfaces?
- What if they express feelings to each other but not to us?
- How do we make sure they are not instrumentalizing us?
